In your relationship with God, do you lean toward grace or do you lean toward truth? What's the problem with either one?

What is the difference between giving Jesus a tour of your life and transferring the title of your life to Him? What do we do to transfer the title of our lives to Jesus?

Read Revelation 3:19-20. What does Jesus tell us to do to put the welcome mat our for Him?

When Jesus says, open the door, what does He mean? Is the God of the universe really waiting for us to open the door?

What does it look like to enjoy your relationship with God? How does it effect your life? What changes? What does it look like to enjoy Jesus?
